

Teller-Park Conservation District Scholarship Award Program Application Due May 1, 2024

The Teller-Park Conservation District is pleased to offer a \$2,000 scholarship to a Teller and Park County high school senior pursuing a degree in conservation, natural resource management, agriculture, or environmental science. One scholarship will be awarded in each county.

The scholarship will be paid directly to the educational institution. Applicants must be attending a Colorado, accredited educational institution.

The Board of Supervisors of the Teller-Park Conservation District will review the applications and award the scholarships at their May board meeting. Scholarship winners will be selected based on a written essay, character, and sincerity.

Eligibility and Requirements

- 1. Applicants must reside in Teller or Park Counties and attend schools in those districts.
- 2. Two letters of recommendation must accompany the application. One letter must be from a school faculty member who has taught the applicant.
- 3. Include a high school transcript.
- 4. An essay no longer than two pages.
- 5. All applications must be received by May 1, 2024.
- The recipient must notify the Teller-Park Conservation District office of acceptance or refusal of the scholarship by email no later than two weeks after the offer. The scholarship will be transferred to an alternate.
